



FLORIDA STATE SOCIETY DAR

The scholarships are open to any student who is a high school graduate or older. Applicants must attend an accredited college or university. Students can be enrolled in either a Florida or out-of-state institution. Applicants applying for the FSSDAR Scholarship must have a GPA of 3.0 or higher. The scholarships are renewable and must meet the requirements of the Re-Award Checklist Form. The minimum GPA for a Re-Award is 3.6.

Applicants must be sponsored by a local DAR chapter with the presiding regent, officer or chapter scholarship chairman's written signature on the Checklist Form. Please follow the directions carefully as applicants spend a great deal of time filling out the forms. Make sure all required copies to be submitted in the packet are correct.

Deadline: Florida scholarship applications must be postmarked by June 1, 2012.

All winners will be notified by mail on July 1. Regents will be notified by email. Scholarship funds will be disbursed by the state treasurer into the students' accounts at their chosen institution, not to the student.
